  - Children's Cancer Association Wagon Event. Local builders, and paint and body shops take MHRC member club sponsored pull wagons, and customize them with their special touch.
    On Sunday, children from the association come to the show and chose a wagon that becomes theirs. They are then personalized to the child's wishes by pinstripers participating in our annual Brush Bash at the PRS.
- Opportunity to participate in our annual Angels on Wheels Toy Run for Randal Children's Hospital at Legacy Emmanuel. 1000's of toys are collected by the MHRC and its member clubs, and then taken to Randal's. It's a heartwarming and worthy activity.
- Each year we donate money for the purchase of stuffed animals for the Portland Ronald McDonald House, helping to make their families stay a more comfortable one.
- Opportunity to help preserve our hobby and create the next generation of automotive mechanics, builders, and designers, through our MHRC Scholarship Program. Thousands of dollars are given out annually to worthy students who have chosen the automotive field as their future.
